The EL Specialist should be considered an expert and willing to continuously improve in the following areas: English Language Development and acquisition, GELN Literacy Essentials, Multi-Tiered Systems of Support, and K-5 curriculum, instruction, and student engagement. Most importantly, the EL Specialist must have a positive, visionary, collaborative outlook on Fennville Public Schools' direction of building the English Learner program.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Enhance FES' Multi-Tiered Systems of support by providing direct English Language Development instruction, intensive literacy or math small group instruction, supporting teachers in providing guaranteed access to curriculum, and contributing to the overall growth and development of FPS' EL Program.
2. Collaborate with Elementary teachers to effectively implement research-based routines for English Learners (ELs), particularly in considering literacy instruction across multiple tiers of support. May include: co-planning, co-teaching, and co-reflecting.
3. Implement and model effective instructional routines based on current research, including: SIOP Model and WIDA Standards Framework. Include a strong knowledge of elementary literacy, math, and content area curriculum in implementation.
4. Contribute to Professional Learning Communities and data review meetings with an EL focused lens. Includes collecting, analyzing, and sharing relevant data for ELs and Former ELs in accordance with local benchmark and progress monitoring data as well as standardized testing data.
5. Support the development of family engagement opportunities for multilingual students.
6. Other duties assigned by Building Principal or EL Director.
