JOB DESCRIPTION: Fennville Public Schools is committed to the growth and development of multilingualism within our community. Through our K-5 Specials rotation, the Elementary Spanish teacher will engage elementary aged students in a creative outlet for language learning. This type of creative outlet may include but is not limited to: learning through the use of play, song, interactive activities, and through the exploration of and connection to the natural world.

Special care should be taken to consider the needs of our diverse community in developing programming that can build upon heritage speakers' existing bilingual skills while also developing skills for newly emerging bilingual students. FPS believes in the value of teaching young children a second language not only for the proven cognitive benefits, but in also developing additional pathways toward bilingual and biliterate opportunities to forge connections in a global society.
