3. Collaborate with Summer Migrant Education Program "Learning Coordinator" to identify student needs based on reading and math benchmark data. Utilize student data to make instructional decisions in the application of Project SMART instructional resource.
4. Demonstrate an understanding of core curricular resources utilized in AM programming to complement PM programming to meet the unique needs of Migratory students.
