3. Develop and implement lessons using research-based best practice instructional design and strategies.
4. Establish and maintain standards of student behavior necessary to provide an orderly, productive classroom environment while respecting individual student needs.
5. Gather, synthesize, and maintain student information in order to make data-based recommendations for intervention and eligibility and participate in IEP meetings, providing appropriate input to meet the students' needs.
6. Evaluate and communicate each student's progress toward meeting his/her individual goals and objectives.
7. Guide students in determining their postsecondary goals and implement appropriate strategies and activities to ensure students are able to reach their post-secondary transition goals.
8. Develop and implement appropriate individualized programs of instruction to meet individual student needs in cooperation with classroom teachers and parents.
9. Serve as a resource person/consultant to the classroom teacher and administration; participate as an educational team member for the success of all students.
10. Create and implement positive behavior intervention plans.
