CLIFFORD E. PAINE VOLUNTEERISM AWARD

This is an annual award and will be presented to a member of the Fennville community who has distinguished himself/herself through community volunteerism and/or through the improvement of educational opportunities for students in the District.

Volunteerism as defined for these purposes will refer to those who offer their own services for little, if any, financial reward.

Basic Procedure:

1. Any person may submit the name(s) of a candidate for this award along with as much pertinent information as possible.
2. The name of the candidate(s) and his/her qualifications, are to be delivered to the office of the Superintendent of Schools by April 15, 2014.
3. While Board members and school employees may be nominated for the Paine Volunteerism Award, they will not be eligible to be the recipient. However, they will receive notification of their nomination as well as a certificate.
4. An individual may receive the Paine Volunteerism Award only one time.
5. A committee, appointed by the Fennville Board of Education, will review all nominations and select the recipient.
6. All qualified candidates shall be awarded a Certificate of Appreciation.
