

Bus Delivery Information

The focus at school this week has been on getting food to students who rely on the school lunch program for their daily nutrition. Our first distribution occurred Tuesday, and yesterday morning we made our first delivery via buses.

As we prepare for Friday's meal distribution, we ask that you please take a moment to read the following information regarding bus delivery:

1. Bus delivery is available to any student who receives bus transportation during the school year **AND** has registered by phone or via the online survey.
2. Bus delivery will occur **ONCE** a day at mid-morning, beginning at 9:30am on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
3. Exact delivery times are not possible. We ask that you please be patient. Our bus drivers and staff are working hard to get the meals delivered as safely and quickly as possible.
4. For safety purposes, bus staff **WILL NOT** cross the road to deliver food. Food will be delivered on the door side of the bus. If a bus passes your bus stop or home, please be patient. The bus driver will circle back around and deliver on your side of the street.
5. A person needs to be present to receive a meal. Staff will not leave meals at doors or bus stops, if a person is not present.
6. We are practicing social distancing and limiting the number of hands on the food bags as much as possible.
