### Remote Learning

- Daily schedule of learning activities
- Lessons aligned with in-person learning
- District-provided technology
- Flexible transition between in-person and remote learning to meet the wide variety of personal and family needs
- Provided for all students during periods of school closure
- Short-term alternative to in-person learning



### In-Person Learning

- Back to school in-person
- Safety protocols in place for students and staff
- Extra attention to cleaning and sanitizing
- Engaging lessons and social interactions
- Fennville curriculum and pacing

### Full-time Virtual Learning

- Offered through Virtual Academy Allegan County (VAAC) in collaboration with other AAESA schools
- District-provided technology
- Local Mentor Teacher for learning support
- Enrolled through Fennville Public Schools
- Eligible for FPS extra-curricular activities and elective courses
- Virtual education with a local connection

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
