Informational/Discussion/Presentation Items

1. Mr. Greydanus gave an update on the interviews for teaching positions at the HS including Math, Science and Special Education. Football coach interviews will begin the week of April 29.
2. Mr. Greydanus presented an idea to expand shared food service director services to include another district. Under this plan, a new position of assistant director would be created for Fennville with the plan for George Siedis to mentor this person to be able to take over as director in the future when George moves on. Under the shared services

plan Fennville would continue to save money in the food service fund. The Board encouraged Mr. Greydanus to continue discussions with other districts.

3. Mr. Greydanus reviewed the plan for administrative realignment prompted by the request to separate the HS Assistant Principal/Athletic Director duties. The Board discussed aspects of the plan and asked questions about the expectations of different positions. The discussion also focused on evaluation of the effectiveness of the plan. Mr. Greydanus presented the anticipated budget savings. The Board encouraged Mr. Greydanus to proceed with the implementation of the plan.
4. Mr. Greydanus shared some of the key points to be discussed at upcoming negotiations for transportation.

Mr. Johnson discussed meal arrangements for the Salmon Release Day on April 26.

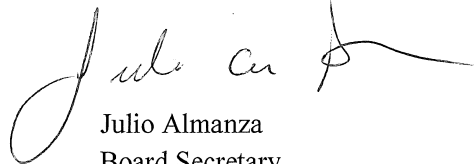
G. ADJOURNMENT
