G. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

- A lengthy discussion between the board and participants on Action Item #2, Return to Learn Plan.
- Mr. Renberg inquired if there would be a change to the last day of school.
- Mr. Renberg asked if the label on the Orbio cleaning solution indicates it kills the COVID-19 virus.
- Mr. Godfrey Facilities Director stated he would investigate the specific ingredients of the Orbio cleaning solution.
- Mr. Renberg asked if there would be a bond update communicated to the community.
- The last day of school would be determined when the FEA agreement is finalized, stated Mr. Johnson.
- A parent asked if the daycare two-week shutdown will become a three-week shut down due to the first day of school moving to September 8.
- The daycare may need to remain open one more week before shutting down for a

thorough cleaning. Mr. Lombard will investigate this further.

- Mr. Sanchez inquired if temperature checks need to be documented. Mr. Greydanus indicated there is no requirement for documentation of daily temperature checks for students or staff.

H. COMMENTS FROM THE BOARD TABLE

- Mr. Thiele noted the active ingredients of the Orbio cleaning solution.
- Mr. Hutchins suggested a questionnaire on symptoms be available online or in an app. Mr. Greydanus reported that the staff will be required to self-screen.
- Nurse Mary and Mr. Lombard are considering creating a magnet to give families listing COVID-19 symptoms.


