SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Mr. Greydanus reviewed information on each of the action items for this meeting.
- Athletic Director Wendell Hughes presented an update on fall sports, community recreation fall programs, and the Southwestern Athletic Conference Expansion.

- Mr. Greydanus introduced Elementary Assistant Principal Beth Ayotte.
- The new 8' gates have been installed at the stadium entrance. The finished look is much better than how the gates were initially installed.
- The administrative team has been working creatively on addressing the substitute teacher shortage. The district will be posting for a full-time substitute teacher soon.
- Mr. Greydanus thanked all the staff who stepped up to help support our needs in covering classes due to the substitute teacher shortage.
- Board members are asked to email suggested names for the strategic planning steering committee to Mr. Greydanus. The committee will begin work in January.
- The administrative team and business office staff will be working on the ESSER spending plan to prepare for the December 15 initial plan submission date for ESSER III.
- Student Council, Choir, students, and staff presented a nice Veteran's Day assembly. We were able to broadcast out to the community for those who were unable to attend.
- The Robotics Team is no longer a part of FIRST Robotics due to the cost and requirements of the program. They will now join VEX Robotics. VEX Robotics will provide more opportunities for students to have fun, learn, and compete in West Michigan.
- Our unaudited FTE student count for Fall 2021 is 1294.60. This is up slightly from 2020's Fall count.
- The Allegan County School Board Association Executive Committee invited Board members to the presentation of The Whole Child Framework, scheduled Thursday, December 2 at 6:30 p.m.
