Informational/Discussion/Presentation Items

1. Mr. Greydanus had presented information from the Health Department on School District Guidance for In-Person Instruction as part of the Superintendent’s report in the earlier meeting.
2. Mr. Greydanus presented the concept of changing the Director of Secondary Student Services into a HS Dean of Students and also hiring a Director of Curriculum and Instruction. Each of these positions would require a teaching certificate so the person could teach part time as needed. Mr. Greydanus will prepare a more formal proposal for future discussions.
3. Mr. Greydanus shared that he had received several district release requests for students to attend Saugatuck outside of the normal schools of choice window. The Board

encouraged Mr. Greydanus to know and follow the SOC rules with regards to these requests.

4. Mr. Greydanus gave a brief update of the bond project progress noting that final inspections to get occupancy of the high school are scheduled for September 3.

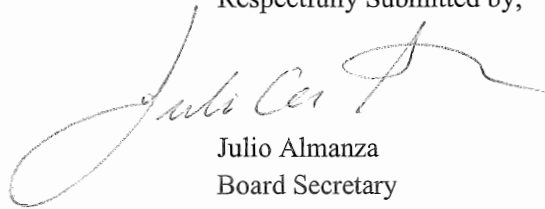
